## ORDINANCE NUMBER 128

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING RESIDENTS OF TUCKERMAN TO CONNECT TO THE SEWER AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE FAILURE TO CONNECT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

RE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TUCKERMAN, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Any owner of real property situated within the City of Tuckerman, Arkansas who shall fail, neglect or reguse to connect such property with the sewer and water system of the City shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less that Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, and each and every day during which such violation shall continue shall be deemed to constitute a separate offense.

Section 2. There is hereby crested a Board of Health to be composed of The Mayor, the Municipal Health Officer, one member of the Water and Sewer Commission to be chosen by the Commission, and one Alderman to be elected by the City Council; and it shall be the duty of the Board of Health whenever in their opinion the public health will be promoted thereby, to notify any property owner, near or adjacent to any sewer line in the City, to connect to such sewer and water line; such notice shall be given in writing and served by the City Marshall upon the property owner.

Section 3. It is hereby declared that the unregulated condition of the disposal of sewage in the City of Tuckerman constitutes a menace to the public health, safety and general welfare, that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety; an emergency is therefore declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
